## Parent / Carer Information

### Scrumdiddlyumptious

### English

This half-term we are reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl in guided reading. We will begin to work on our inference and vocabulary understanding. In writing we will be using a variety of exciting books as inspiration to write in a variety of styles.

### Maths

This half-term we will be focussing on place value and the four main operations: additions, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will use equipment, discussions and written methods to understand each in detail.

### History

We will be learning all about Maya civilisation, we will be finding out who the Mayans are and what they did. We will look at their ways of life then and compare to ours today. We will learn about Maya gods, the community and important people of the period.

## Scrumdiddlyumptious!

### Geography

We will be using maps and atlases to locate areas in the world where cocoa is produced. We will be exploring the physical and human features of these areas and learning about the people that live there and their way of life.

### RE

In RE we be learning about Hinduism and some stories, which are important to Hindus.

### Computing

In Computing we will be developing our coding skills, we will look at how they are used by computers and design our own codes to make objects perform actions.

### PE

In PE we will build on what we learnt last year and develop our ball skills, practicing these in a number of ways. We will develop our team work skills alongside this by playing team ball games.

### DT

We will be investigating various chocolate product packaging and from this design our own packaging based on a brief set for us. We will also be making and evaluating our designs once completed.

### Science

We will be investigating plants, including parts of a plant, the role of a flower in the life cycle of a plant and different pollinators. Practical activities will include dissecting a flower and working with seeds to deduce how they are dispersed.
